DRAFT RESTRICTIONS

PANAMAX:

Max Draft: 12.04 meters (39.5 feet = 39 feet 6 inches) in the deepest point of immersion in Tropical Fresh Water (TFW) permitted for particular vessel in Gatun Lake. Water Density of Gatun Lake is 0.9954 at 29.4°C (85°F).

NEOPANAMAX:

15.24m (50.0 feet) Tropical Fresh Water (TFW) since June 9th, 2021

*Remarks:

- Regular: Vessel with beam<91 feet
- Super: Vessel with 91 feet<=beam<=107 feet
- Neopanamax: Vessel with beam>107 feet
- Panamax Plus: Vessel with 91 feet<=beam<=107 feet, but draft>39.5 Feet (12.04m)TFW
