Same road. Who ever is looking at approving the quarry licence in DEL should be advised that TPW **still** own the road and **NOT** Global Quarry.

I should also point out that the Department **MAY** under a Breaking Soil permit allow at their expense the adjacent owners (Global Quarry) to lower the existing road bed to an acceptable level for their quarry operation **however I would suspect that EDHO will want to be involved in any permit issued due to the sensitive nature(political) that the permit** will stirr up. Any permit issued by the Department MUST have DEL and DFO approval with Global Quarry being held totally responsible for any problems, including environmental , that may develop in the future

The owners of the quarry site approached TPW a couple of years ago to purchase the old abandoned ROW (White Cove Road, Authority # 0422) in Digby Municipality that passes through their property towards the Bay of Fundy however after review by TPW staff including EDHO the proponents of the quarry were advised by mail just recently that the Department was **NOT** prepared to sell the old ROW as requested at this time. Their \$ 150 application fee was also returned to them. See the attached letter dated 14 February 2005.

This file (about 3 " thick) is extensive with petitions, letters, pictures, legal survey plan etc. DEL and DFO also have been on the site and ordered TPW to do work within the old abandoned road ("K" Class) to stop siltation from reaching the Bay of Fundy.

Trusting this is the information required.
