Dear Jean:

DFO has reviewed the letter from Paul Buxton dated July 2004 informing the Agency that Bilcon of Nova Scotia is now the Proponent of the Whites Point Quarry project and that the permit issued by Nova Scotia Environment and Labour for the 3.9 hectare test quarry at Whites Point is no longer valid.

DFO has no objection to the Agency amending the Memorandum of Understanding to reflect the status of ownership for Whites Point Quarry and understands that Bilcon does not intend to request the Nova Scotia Department of Environment and Labour to transfer the 3.9 hectare quarry permit now held by Nova Stone Exporters Incorporated.

DFO is assuming that the 3.9 hectare quarry associated with this project is included as part of the larger quarry and that it will be included in the scope of the project. DFO recommends that a caveat be added to the MOU reflecting this assumption.
