Hi Rosalia,

This email should have accompanied the fact sheet entitled FACTSHEET Blasting- Fish and Fish Habitat Protection, I gave to you on Friday, January 9, 2004. A blasting plan must be submitted by the proponent to be considered under CEAA. In turn, this plan should be 1. developed by the contractor who will be doing the blasting and 2. developed according to the FACTSHEET considerations. Also, the blasting plan should include fish species inhabiting the Tiverton area along with their window of occurrence. In addition, this plan should address Species at Risk which may inhabit the Tiverton area along with their window of occurrence. Remember to include mitigation measures to be used by the blaster to minimize effects of blasting on fish and Species at Risk.

If you have any questions concerning the development of a blasting plan, please let me know and I will try to assist you. Have a great day!!!
