I have no problem attending a public meeting however the decision NOT to declare the road surplus to Department needs was made by EDHO ( Martin Delaney).

I have NO presentation prepared to present nor do I feel that TPW should present anything to the group. This topic is still **VERY** political in the Area with the local MLA and Municipality of Digby on record as against the start of any quarry along Digby Neck.

Most of the opponents to the quarry are hoping that TPW will have a policy or procedure to stop the process. I do not believe that we do but stand to be corrected.

**I understand that there may be a court ruling on the legal access across Bilcon property to the abandoned (TPW) highway thus giving legal access to the 50 X 50 foot parcel of property past the end of the public listing of the road but I'm not sure when it came down or if in fact there was a court ruling.**

I'm not sure what TPW will be able to contribute to the discussions other than to say the intersection of the White Cove Road and Route 217 meet the commercial safe stopping sight distance requirements of the Department. Any request to work on the abandon road under a Breaking Soil Permit must have the approval of the Area Manager under specific conditions which will include approval by DEL and DFO.

Should a question of policy arise my comment to the group would have to be that I will record the question and obtain a response for the group.

What time is the meeting and where?
