As per our telephone conversation today, I would like to indicate some changes I plan to make to the final CEAA screening document for Tiverton.

Issue B14:

1. Pre-blast caps will be detonated ...area; will be changed to fish and mammals will be scared from the area (i.e.. using a boat or pre-blast caps)
2. The date of the blasting plan will be changed to reflect the revised blasting plan submission
3. Reference to the Guideline for the use of explosives will be removed and reference will be made to the FACTSHEET Blasting-Fish and Fish Habitat Protection.
4. The EPP section will be revised to reflect how the EPP will indicate the mitigation measures identified in the final CEAA screening.
