RE: **Approval to Construct and Operate a Quarry at Tiverton**
Approval No. 2003-032388

An inspection was carried out at your quarry operation on August 6, 2003. The section of road from the private driveway leading up-hill to the site of the quarry workings is eroding. It was noted that there are no erosion or sedimentation controls in place at this location and substantial amounts of soil are being carried from the sides of this roadway and deposited onto the adjacent field by rainwater and surface drainage.


Section 4. of the Approval 2002-032388 states that:

- a) All erosion and sedimentation controls are to be in place prior to construction at this Facility. The Nova Scotia Department of the Environment "*Erosion and Sedimentation Control Handbook for Construction Sites*" shall serve as the reference document for all erosion control measures. These measures are minimum requirements and additional controls shall be implemented if Site runoff exceeds the discharge limits contained herein.
- b) All erosion and sedimentation controls are to be maintained and remain in place until the disturbed areas are stabilized.

Your immediate attention to this situation is required to prevent further erosion at this site. Please contact me as soon as erosion and sedimentation controls are in place and work is completed.
