Please be advised that, with respect to the Belleoram Continental Stone Quarry Project, we have been advised verbally by the proponent's consultant, (with a letter to follow from the proponent), that the project will now be configured such that there will be no harmful alteration, disruption or destruction of fish habitat (HADD) resulting from the aspects of this project other than that arising from the Marine Terminal itself. As a result of there being no HADD for the components of the project other than the Marine terminal there will be no requirement to consider the issuance of a S. 35(2) Fisheries Act Authorization and therefore no further requirement for a CEAA review at any level.

As you already have DFO's letter of support regarding the EA Track Report for the Comprehensive Study of the Marine Terminal component of the project (as per DFO's scope of project) I assume that all issues outstanding on this project have been addressed at this time.
