The Joint Review Panel (the Panel) responsible for assessing the potential environmental effects of the proposed Marathon Platinum Group Metals and Copper Mine project (the Project) has completed its review of the responses to the supplemental information requests provided by Stillwater Canada Inc. (SCI), as well as the corresponding public comments, and has determined that there is sufficient information to proceed to the public hearing. The purpose of this letter is to invite Fisheries and Oceans Canada to attend the public hearing and present its views on the Project and its environmental effects to the Panel. The Panel is aware of the expertise that exists in Fisheries and Oceans on matters associated with the environmental assessment of the Project. Therefore, the Panel, in accordance with section 20 of the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act, 2012* and as outlined in sections 5.1 and 5.3 of its Terms of Reference, requests the participation of Fisheries and Oceans Canada in the public hearing.

The Panel invites Fisheries and Oceans Canada to present its technical review on the potential environmental effects of the Project and to provide information and recommendations to the Panel as they relate to the department's expertise and mandate. Specifically, the Panel is interested in the department's expertise on the following:

- the potential effects of the Project;
- the proposed mitigation and compensation measures;
- the conclusions reached by the Proponent regarding the significance of the effects;

- recommendations for how best to address any remaining concerns.

Sufficient information and analysis should be provided to support Fisheries and Oceans Canada's conclusions and recommendations, particularly if they differ from those presented by Stillwater Canada Inc. or other participants.
