You will recall that the federal committee has agreed to provide technical guidance to the proponent while it is developing the EIS, to help ensure consistency with various regulatory interests of the expert agencies that will ultimately be reviewing the finished EIS and providing comments to the Panel. This guidance is provided on the understanding that it cannot be construed as acceptance or endorsement of the EIS by those agencies; the ultimate decision on EIS adequacy remains with the Panel.

I have attached a portion of the preliminary draft EIS that I received yesterday. It describes the EA process and regulatory environment. I will be on vacation from August 8 to 26 inclusive. Therefore I ask that that you provide me with any comments you have by August 26, so that I will be able to deal with them on upon my return.
