- 6. Do you have any preconceived opinions concerning the implementation or the carrying out of this project, or its potential environmental effects?
- 7. Are you, or have you ever been engaged in any activity that might be perceived by others as indicating that you do have such preconceived opinions?
- 8. Are you, or your direct family (wife/husband and/or children) engaged in any activity that is, or might be perceived as a conflict of interest if you were appointed?
- 9. Is there any other element, information or point you would like to raise or bring forward that could be associated with a real, potential or perceived conflict of interest?
- 10. Are you able to devote the time and energy required to complete this panel review in a timely manner?
- 11. Are there any limitations and/or conditions that would have to be met before you would allow your name to be put forward for consideration as a member of the panel?
