Yes, both Habitat -F.A. ss.35(2) and Navigable Waters - NWPA ss. 5 (1) have triggered CEAA. My letter to Global only mentions the NWP trigger because it was the one initiated first. There may be another F.A. trigger - s. 32 - if the blasting is likely to kill fish. Section 35 prohibits any harmful alteration, disruption or destruction of fish habitat unless a authrization from our Minister is issued (the issueing of the authorization is actually the trigger here.) Section 32 prohibits the killing of fish by means other than fishing. An authorization must be issued here as well if fish are likely to be killed by blasting or any other physical activity associated with the project. We will need more information to determine this.
