One of the largest bridges in Russia, it consists of parallel road and rail lines with a length of 19 km. The route begins on the Taman Peninsula and passes along the existing 5-kilometer seawall and Tuzla Island. It then crosses the Kerch Strait, curving to the north of Cape Ak-Burun, and makes landfall on the Crimean shore.
